Please note the following required documentation and payment that must accompany your Education Prescreening Form for your form to be considered by our Credentialing Committee:

1. If your graduate program was CACREP or COAMFTE accredited, a verification letter from your graduate program stating that your program was CACREP or COAMFTE accredited at the time of your graduation must accompany your Education Prescreening Form. ***A verification letter must accompany your Education Prescreening Form to be considered.***

2. If your graduate program was not CACREP or COAMFTE accredited, we require that you complete the Clinical Domain table portion of our Education Prescreening Form. **Please include transcripts and course descriptions of all courses listed on the Clinical Domain table.** ***Transcripts (unofficial transcripts will be accepted) and complete course descriptions must accompany your Education Prescreening Form to be considered.***

3. OMHA charges a \$25.00 non-refundable fee for reviewing your prescreening information. Please include a \$25.00 check (made out to: OMHA, 291 West 12th Street Eugene, OR 97401) with your prescreening form.

Your Education Prescreening Form will be reviewed by our Credentialing Committee, which generally meets the first Monday of each month. If you have the necessary training in mental health intervention, then our Credentialing Committee will send you an application packet to apply to be a member of the Oregon Mental Health Associates, Inc. panel. Your application packet will then be reviewed by our Credentialing Committee on the first Credentialing Meeting following our receipt of your application. If your application is accepted by our Credentialing Committee, you will receive written notification of your acceptance on our panel and any pertinent contracts will follow.
